This free and confidential service is available to owner-occupiers and private tenants who are at least 60 years of age or anyone with a disability.

The service is for older people and people with disabilities who live in the Borders. It provides practical help with small tasks around the home including changing light bulbs, fitting locks and security items, replacing tap washers and unblocking sinks, fitting curtain rails and moving furniture within the house. The service does not include painting and decorating, gas and electric work, chimney and roof repairs or gardening.
